Title: Regarding Cadre structuring in Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research, Puducherry- Laid

**SHRI VE. VAITHILINGAM (PUDUCHERRY):** Jawaharlal Institute of Post graduate Medical Education and Research (JIPMER) was established in 1964 at Puducherry by the then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru. Now 230 faculties, 360 resident physicians, 3000 nursing, administrative and support staff are working.

During 2008 after conversion of Institute as Institute of National Importance, pay scales have been revised in uniformity with RR (Recruitment Rules) for faculties in AIIMS, PGIMER and JIPMER. For non faculty posts a coordination committees was formed and it had submitted its reports on 3.8.3016. It recommended to have uniformity in pay scales, cadre structures and RR in respect of various non-faculty posts on AIIMS PGIMER and JIPMER. Based on that, the cadre restructure proposed for 26 cadres was submitted to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare by JIPMER. Out of which only 3 cadres were approved by Ministry on 10.8.2018 and the rest is pending.

Hence, I request the Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family Welfare to take necessary steps for approving 23 cadres in JIPMER at the earliest.
