Ttile: Regarding development of the Aligarh Muslim University Centre in Malappuram Parliamentary Constituency of Kerala.

SHRI P.K. KUNHALIKUTTY (MALAPPURAM): Hon. Speaker, I would like to bring to the attention of the Government about the pathetic condition of the Aligarh Muslim University Campus in my Constituency. This Campus is a beautiful one and enough grant has been given by the Government. All the infrastructure, etc. is there. This Centre has submitted a good DPR to the Government. But in the last four or five years, the Central Government has not sanctioned any fund to this Campus.

As a result of this, this Centre is facing a great difficulty. Now, we are talking of *sabka saath* and *sabka vishwas*, *beti bachao beti padhao*, etc. But this Centre which is intended to spread education for all, has not been sanctioned any fund. So, this is a kind of discrimination. Not a single paisa has been sanctioned over the last four or five years to this Aligarh Muslim University Campus.

So, I request the Government to sanction sufficient funds for this Campus. At least for the DPR, funds should be sanctioned. Thank you.
