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Title: Issue regarding unsettled Indo-Myanmar International boundry, particularly lying alongside the Manipur State.

**DR. R.K. RANJAN (INNER MANIPUR):** Hon. Speaker, Sir, thank you very much for this opportunity to speak for the first time. Sir, I bow down to my Supreme God, Nongda Lairen Pakhangba, and, I also salute the people of Manipur for empowering me to say a few words here.

Sir, Manipur was a princely State and it was merged with Indian Union on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 1949 with an intention that the territorial boundary of erstwhile Manipur will be protected by the Union Government. But we lost 20,201 square kilometres of Manipur's land which was Indian territorial land as it was given to the present Myanmar. On 10<sup>th</sup> March, 1967 again, our boundary was further receded towards the valley area by Indo-Burma Commission.

So, there is an unsettled Indo-Myanmar international boundary till today. I want to know whether there is any means to review the work of Indo-Myanmar Boundary Commission and also the demarcation done in 1975 so that the people's aspiration may be fulfilled as the anti-Indian feeling among the local people is rising because of the loss of the territorial boundary. Thank you.
