Title: Need to implement 10% reservation for economically backward classes in the state of Telangana.

***SHRI BANDI SANJAY KUMAR :** Hon. Speaker Sir, after formation of BJP led Government under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi, many welfare schemes were introduced for the welfare of SCs, STs and OBCs. Whole country is aware the funds are being provided for the upliftment of these sections. Central Government has also provided 10% reservation for economically backward sections of upper castes. This reservation is being implemented throughout the country, but Telangana Government is not implementing this provision and neglecting the economically backward classes. I request Hon. Minister to take cognizance of this matter. As the Central Government opposed unconstitutional and unlawful proposal of Telangana Government to provide 10% reservation for Muslims, now, Telangana Government is not implementing 10% reservation for economically backward classes of upper castes.

Earlier, Congress tried to provide 4% reservation for Muslims and tried to include Muslims under BC category. Now, TRS Government is making unconstitutional and impractical promises to provide 10 to 12% reservation to minorities and on the other hand they are depriving economically backward classes of upper castes of 10% reservation. Telangana Government is behaving in an adamant and high handed manner by not implementing 10% reservation to economically backward classes of upper castes. I request that Central Government should take immediate action to see that economically backward classes of upper

castes get benefit of 10% reservation in the State of Telangana. Telangana Government is not implementing Central Government's welfare schemes for poor like Ayushman Bharat Yojana, Fasal Bhima Yojana, or Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, as implementation of these schemes would give credit and fame to the Central Government. I request the Union Government to take action and see that 10% reservation for economically backward classes is implemented in the state of Telangana.
