Title: Regarding a dumping ground in Jalpaiguri district, West Bengal -
laid.

DR. JAYANTA KUMAR ROY (JALPAIGURI): Today while the Government is focusing on a clean and green environment, a massive dumping ground in Jalpaiguri district has been spread over ten acres of land, surrounded by 18 institutions.

The ground water has been contaminated to such an extent that Black grease comes out of the taps in the locality. Further, the dumping ground waste is being burnt on a regular basis which pollutes the environment.

The Fafri Forests and the adjoining river has now been contaminated by the particular dumping ground.

I would like to remind that the particular dumping ground is also a matter of National Security as 3 Gas Pipe Lines pass through the Dumping Ground and often cracks in the pipe line have been detected.
