Title: Need to make Hooghly river pollution-free -laid.

SHRIMATI LOCKET CHATTERJEE (HOOGHLY): Hooghly river is one of the main tributaries of Ganga in West Bengal that is being polluted day in day out. Ganga gets most polluted in West Bengal. My constituency is named after the Hooghly river and I feel sad as my constituency contributes a lot to this pollution. The main reason for pollution is the dumping of untreated sewage in the river. Around 20 canals dump their waste directly into the river. The holy river turns murky grey when it passes through the Dakshineshwar temple.
