Wild Elephant Attack

3551. SHRI PRAJWAL REVANNA:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of recurring problem of wild elephant attack in the vicinity of forest areas of Alur sakleshpura and Belur taluks of Hassan Lok Sabha Constituency and thereby affecting the life and livelihood of the people;
- (b) if so, the details of loss of life and loss of crops in the said area during the last three years along with the details of compensation paid to the affected families;
- (c) whether adequate forest staff and forest watchers are posted in the said area to save the life and prevent crop damage and if so, the details thereof along with the details of number of elephants captured and rehabilitated so far; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to install more steel rope barricade and electric fences in the said area and if so, the details thereof?

- (a)&(b) As per the information received from the State of Karnataka, the details of loss of life and crops/property and the ex gratia paid in the last three years is enclosed as Annexure.
- (c) &(d) As per the information received from the State of Karnataka, in addition to the permanent frontline staff (Deputy Range Forest Officers-cum-Surveyors, Forest Guards and Forest Watchers), non-permanent watchers are deployed as Anti-Depredation Camps (ADC) and Rapid Response Teams whose details are given below:

A total of 74 wild elephants have been captured and rehabilitated since 2000 till date. Moreover, in addition to ongoing installation of barricade and solar fence, the State of Karnataka has constructed 9.50 km railway barricade and 14.0 km tentacle solar fence so far to mitigate human-elephant conflict.
