CORAL REEPS

*1130. Shri Muniswamy: Will the Minister of Natural Resources and Scientific Research be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that recent investigation of the Gulf of Mannar, by the Geological Survey of India showed that large quantities of coral reefs may be available in those areas;
- (b) if so, whether Government have taken adequate steps to exploit the maximum benefit out of it; and
- (c) whether it is a fact that small scale manufacture of bleaching powder. caustic soda could be made out of these coral reefs?

The Minister of Education and Natural Resources and Scientific Research (Maulana Azad): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The results of the investigation carried out by the Geological Survey of India have been forwarded to the Government of Madras, as the exploitation of mineral resources is the responsibility of the State Government concerned.
- (c) The coral reefs are reported to contain over 96 per cent. of calcium carbonate and may find use in the manufacture of chemicals like bleaching powder, caustic soda, etc.

The expenditure incurred by the State Government on the monuments and sites of national importance and the staff employed on them was to be met by the Government of India.
