of rice from Thailand to Korea were given by India in 1950.

(c) and (d). Yes, Government have been approached from time to time for contributions but, in view of their own enormous economic problems, they have not been able to offer any further assistance to the U. N. Korea Reconstruction Agency.

ELECTRIC LIGHT TO GOVERNMENT BUILD-INGS

- (d) About 30 lakhs.

- (a) what is the result of the survey of the Manas River Project in Assam; and
- (b) the amount that has been spent for the survey of the Project up-to-

date and what will be the total cost of construction of the same?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): (a) The surveys have not yet been completed.

(b) The amount spent up to the end of July, 1953 is Rs. 4,34,800. The cost of construction of the Project can be estimated only after the investigations have been completed and the necessary designs and estimates prepared
