SURVEY TRAINING SCHOOL

\*710. Shri Bahadur Singh: Will the Minister of Natural Resources and Scientific Research be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any students were deputed by neighbouring countries for training in the Survey Training School at Dehra Dun during 1953-54; and
- (b) if so, the number of students deputed and the names of the countries they came from?

The Deputy Minister of Natural Resources and Scientific Research (Shri K. D. Majaviya); (a) Yes, Sir

(b) 2 from Burma and 6 from Ceylon.

Shri Bahadur Singh: What particular branches of survey are taught here, and what is the duration of the training?

Shri K. D. Malaviya: The duration is two years in one case for the complete training, and there is also a Training course, of six months. The technical subjects which are taught there are ground surveying, map drawing and the handling of various precision instruments that are used for survey work.

Shri Bahadur Singh: Will this be a regular feature, and did the students from foreign countries come only during 1953 or do they come every year?

Shri K. D. Malaviya: As there is no other facility in the whole Continuent of Asia with regard to training in survey work, countries which are friendly to us and are our neighbours, send us their students for training. It is not a regular feature.

Shri Bahadur Singh: Do the Government of India bear the expenditure of the students who come from foreign countries, or do the respective foreign Governments bear it?

Shri K. D. Malaviya: The respective countries bear it.

Shri M. D. Ramaswami: May I know the number of Indian students trained in this Survey Training School?

Shri K. D. Malaviya: On an average twenty-nine students, belonging both to Government of India and State Governments and outside countries, were trained in 1953-54.
