actually pursuing it. As a matter of fact, by the end of the period of the Plan we propose to complete this scheme.

SAVINGS BANK DEPOSITS

*2002. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of deposits in the Post Office Savings Bank in the year 1953-54 as far as available; and
- (b) how it compares with the figures for the same period of the previous year?

The Deputy Minister of Communications (Shri Raj Bahadur): (a) and (b). The approximate gross amount of deposits during 1953-54 was Rs. 1.11,55,51,000 as against Rs. 1,09,40,85,000 during 1952-53.

Shri D. C. Sharma: May I know, Sir, if the Postal Department is taking any additional measures to step up postal savings deposits?

Shri Raj Bahadur: The Postal Department functions as an agency of the Ministry of Finance in this respect. They do take certain steps.

Shri D. C. Sharma: May I know, Sir, if any particular drive is being carried out to raise these deposits in the rural areas of India?

Shri Raj Bahadur: That again is not a function of this Ministry.

CENTRAL RICE RESEARCH INSTITUTE, CUTTACK

*2003. Shri Sanganna: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any practical training is being imparted to agriculturists in modern methods of agriculture at the Central Rice Research Institute, Cuttack;
- (b) if so, the number of agriculturists who received training in 1953; and
- (c) what expenditure was incurred for this purpose during the above period?

The Minister of Agriculture (Dr. P. S. Deshmukh): (a) Yes.

- (b) 14.
- (c) Rs. 357.

Shri Sanganna: May I know whether such training will be given every year to agriculturists?

Dr. P. S. Deshmukh: I think it will be continued.

Shri Sanganna: May I know whether the cost of training will be borne by the Central Government or the State Governments?

Dr. P. S. Deshmukh: There is no cost beyond Rs. 357, which was the cost incurred on the mid-day meals to the farmers who were attending.
