GOPAL TEXTILE MILLS, BROA

- *1420. Shri C. Bhatt: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Messers. Gopal Textile Mills, Broach has closed down suddenly on the 6th March, 1954;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the Railway authorities did not supply wagons for coal to this Mill in time which has resulted in the closing down; and
- (c) whether Government propose to supply immediately coal and also arrange for wagons to the said Mill?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari):
(a) It is understood that Gopal Mills remained closed from 6th to 8th March, 1954.

- (b) No. Sir. This Mill's monthly allotment was 68 wagons (1846 tons) which is their normal requirement on a two shift basis. During January and February 1954 the Railways had allotted 136 wagons.
- (c) Arrangements have already been made for additional aliotments of coal to this Mill which has recently started working a third shift.
