HEALTH CENTRE IN DELHI UNIVERSITY

*623. **Sardar Hukam Singh:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether the World University Service has agreed to contribute some amount for the opening of a health centre in the Delhi University Campus under a Subsidised Medical Aid Scheme for teachers and students;

(b) what will be the contribution of the Government of India; and

(c) the other places where the World University Service has assisted in the opening of such centres in India?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) Yes.

(b) Rupees 17,000/- already sanctioned for current expenditure for the year 1954-55. Nonrecurring expenditure is under consideration.

(c) There is a proposal under consideration for starting a Students' Health Centre in the Patna University.

Sardar Hukam Singh: What is the contribution that the teachers and the students have to make for this scheme?

Dr. M. M. Das: It has been proposed that the health centre will charge the following rate of contribution from the participants in the scheme:

Resident students—Rs. 6 per head per annum.

Non-resident students—Rs. 2 per head per annum.

Class IV servants—Annas eight per head per month.

Other members of the staff—Not yet decided.

Dr. Rama Rao: May I know the nature of the services that will be offered in these health centres?

Dr. M. M. Das: Medical facilities will be offered to the participants.

Shri Raghavaiah: What are the countries that have contributed to this World University Service?

Dr. M. M. Das: I require notice.

Shrimati Renu Chakravarty: What is this World University Service? Is it part of the United Nations, or what is it? And how did this body come into existence?

Dr. M. M. Das: It is an organisation, I think, under the UNESCO.

HOSTELS

*626. **Dr. Ram Subhag Singh:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to give aid to various universities for the construction of hostels;

(b) if so, whether any aid had been sanctioned for this purpose during 1953-54; and

(c) if so, to which university and to what extent?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) to (c). A general scheme for this purpose is under consideration. Loans has been given to the following university departments of Engineering and Technology for construction of hostels during 1953-54:—

1. Banaras Hindu University (College of Technology and Pharmaceutics)	Rs. 1,11,000
2. Annamalal University (College of Engineering).	Rs. 1,00,000
