## LOANS TO LOCAL BODIES

- °1209. Dr. Ram Subhag Singh: Will the Minister of Transport be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Government propose to advance loans to certain local bodies in the States for enabling them to meet their share of the cost of construction of bridges and under-bridges to replace Railway level-crossings; and
- (b) if so, what is the estimated amount to be given during 1954-55?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) Vac

(b) An amount of Rs. 50 lakhs has been earmarked in the provision made in the Five Year Plan for the grant of such loans during 1954-55 and 1955-56. The amount to be given as loans 398 L.S.D.

during the current year cannot be estimated at present as proposals for the grant of loans are still awaited from a number of State Governments.

Dr. Ram Subhag Singh: know whether the amount which proposed to be given to the local bodies will also be given to the district boards, because most of the over-bridges and under-bridges are going to be constructed in the rural areas?

Shri Alagesan: That is SO. cost of these bridges will have to be borne by the local bodies. Instead of making a loan direct to the bodies, we advance the loan to State Government, who in turn will advance the loan to the local bodies.

Dr. Ram Subhag Singh: May I know on what basis these loans are going to be advanced, whether the cost of construction of the bridges is taken into account, or the loans are going to be advanced only on an ad hoc basis?

Shri Alagesan: No, the share of the cost of these bridges 'll be taken into dvancing these consideration befol, lpans.
