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- (b) if so, the estimated cost thereof; and
- (c) by what time the construction of the bridge is expected to be commenced and completed?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) Yes; it is proposed to construct bridges across the two branches of the river Godavari called Gautami and Vasista.

- (b) Gautami bridge—Rs. 124.79 lakhs. Vasista bridge—About Rs. 65 lakhs.
- (c) The Gautami bridge is expected to be commenced early in 1955 and the Vasista bridge in the latter part of 1955. It will take about five years for the construction of the Gautami bridge and about three years for the construction of the Vasista bridge.

(d) Any decision in this context will have to be taken for Central Government employees as a whole.
