

PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN KUTCH

*1286. **Shri Dholakia:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether there are any Primary Schools in Kutch State where Harijan students are not admitted;

(b) if so, the number of such private and Government Schools; and

(c) the number of such private schools as receive 'grant-in-aid' from Government?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) to (c). The information is being collected and will be placed on the Table of the Lok Sabha in due course.

Shri Velayudhan: May I know whether the Government have got information from any other State where Harijan children are not admitted in the primary schools in spite of that Government order?

Dr. M. M. Das: We have got no information.

*१२८७. **श्री रघुनाथ सिंह:** क्या शिक्षा मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि:

(क) क्या सरकार ने ब्रिटिश स्मारकों के सम्बन्ध में सारे राज्यों में लागू करने के लिये एकरूप नीति बनाई है; और

(ख) क्या किसी राज्य ने इस सम्बन्ध में कोई योजना भेजी है?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) The matter is under consideration.

(b) Some of the States have sent preliminary information about such monuments.

श्री रघुनाथ सिंह: इन स्टेटों के नाम हम जान सकते हैं?

Dr. M. M. Das: The Central Government asked the States to send detailed catalogues of these monuments, statues etc. The States of Andhra, Bengal and Bombay have sent such catalogues. We are expecting such detailed reports from U.P. and Madras.

Shri Raghuramalah: May I know whether the Central Government have indicated any general lines to the States on which these statues should be disposed of?

Dr. M. M. Das: The Central Government have written to the States to know two things; one is a detailed list of these statues etc., and the other, the views of the Chief Ministers of the States. These views have not yet been received by us.

Shri M. L. Dwivedi: What are the recommendations of the Madras Government in this respect?

Dr. M. M. Das: The Madras Government have written to us that this question will be considered by the Madras Cabinet in the month of September.

Sardar A. S. Saigal rose—

Mr. Speaker: Order, order. I am going to the next question. It is no use asking information about each separate State.
