(b) In what States is it produced and what is the approximate acreage under cultivation at present?

The Minister of Food and Agri-culture (Shri Kidwai): (a) Tapioca contains about 38.7 per cent. Carbo-hydrates, 0.7 per cent. protein, 0.2 per cent. fat, 1 per cent. minerals, and moisture 59.4 per cent. Its calorifi-value per ounce is 45 and it is defi-cient in witcomice cient in vitamins.

It is mainly used as a supplementary food in Travancore and the Malabar district of Madras.

(c) There has not been any avoid-able delay in this matter. Govern-ment was awaiting the Report of the Rajadhyaksha Committee and have ordered further Police investigations based on this Report.
