Shri Gurupadaswamy: I want to know whether there has been a refusal?

Mr. Speaker: The same question is being repeated.

Shri K. Subrahmanyam: In the case of the offer from China may I know whether the money will be paid to the Chinese Embassy in India?

Shri Kidwai: I do not know about the arrangement for payment. The agreement signed there has not yet reached us but the money will be paid according to the usual channels.

Shri G. P. Sinha: Is it a fact that the said country's demand is for supply of essential commodities in exchange for grains?

Shri Kidwai: But I have said that the arrangement is on a cash basis.

## RATIONING

\*515. Shri Velayudhan: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

- (a) the States where the ration has been increased recently; and
- (b) the States which demanded the increase of their ration?

The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri Kidwai): (a) Only in Travancore-Cochin has there been an increase in the over-all ration during this year.

(b) None.

Shri Velayudhan: May J know whether the Government is aware that while this increase has been ordered no ration is given?

Shri Kidwai: If the hon. Member brings to my notice any case where the rations are not supplied then I will ask the Travancore-Cochin Government to look into the matter.

Shri Velayudhan: May I know whether Government is aware that there is a decrease in the purchase of rations by the cardholders after the rise in the price of rations?

Shri Kidwai: I am not aware of it but I will make enquiries if the hon. Member so desires.

Shri Funnoose: Can the Minister tell us the amount of ration that is given in the Travancore-Cochin State?

Shri Kidwai: Rice 6 oz. and wheat 6 oz.

Shri Pocker Saheb: May I know whether there has not been a demand from the State of Madras for an increase in the rice ration? Shri Kidwai: Yes, there has been a demand for the increase of the rice portion of the rations.

श्री एम॰ एल॰ दिवेदी : क्या मैं माननीय मंत्री महोदय से यह पूछ सकता हूं कि दिल्ली राज्य में चावल की किस्म में कोई सुधार होने की उम्मीद हैं ?

[Shri M. L. Dwivedi: May I know whether there is any possibility of supplying better quality rice in Delhi?]

श्री किस्वर्द : क्षोशिश की जा रही है कि विन्य्य प्रदेश से यहां चावल मंगाया जाय और उम्मीद है कि वह अच्छा होगा।

[Shri Kidwai: Efforts are being made to get rice here from Vindhya Pradesh the quality of which is expected to be better.]

Shri Punnoose: Is he aware that at present in Travancore-Cochin the quantity of ration is 4½ oz. rice plus 1½ oz wheat? That comes to 6 oz.?

Shri Kidwai: I have got before meinformation that six ounces of rice and 6 ounces of other cereals are being supplied in the rationed areas.

Kumari Annie Mascarene: That is not being given effect to.

Mr. Speaker: Order, order.

Shrimati Renu Chakravartty: In view of the long period of austerity rations in rice-eating areas and in view of the fact that we are getting rice from various other countries to meet the shortage, is there any proposal before Government to increase the amount of rice given to rice-eating States like West Bengal?

Shri Kidwai: Rice is being imported only to be supplied to States where there is shortage of rice.
