

## N. C. C. TRAINING

\*914. **Shri Balmiki:** Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) how many teachers from various States have been invited for N.C.C. training in 1952;

(b) the centres for this training; and

(c) the nature of the training?

The **Deputy Minister of Defence (Shri Satish Chandra):** (a) 117 Professors and 217 School teachers have undergone pre-commission training in 1952.

(b) The training was given at 17 Centres, a list of which is placed on the Table of the House. [See Appendix V, annexure No. 34]

(c) The Officer cadets are trained in the handling of weapons and the basic principles of military and technical subjects so that they may be capable of supervising the training of cadets upto the standard required to pass the Senior Certificate Examination of their respective arms of service.

**Shri Frank Anthony:** Is it a fact, Sir, that during training Professors from Colleges who belong to the senior section are treated as officers while teachers from schools belonging to the junior section are treated either as J.C.Os. or other ranks?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** Sir, I could not give these details off-hand; but I believe the rules regarding these have been published.

**श्री एच० एच० डिबेबी :** क्या माननीय मंत्री कृपा करके बतलायेंगे कि कामधीर में नौबल कैंपेट कोर की योजना के अन्तर्गत कितने शिक्षार्थियों को अब तक शिक्षा दी गई है ?

**श्री लतीफ चन्द :** अलग अलग स्टेट्स के बारे में तो इस समय मेरे पास फिगरस नहीं हैं ।

**श्री एच० एच० डिबेबी :** क्या कामधीर में कोई-सी योजना चल रही है या ऐसे कैंम्प है ?

**श्री लतीफ चन्द :** स्टेटमेंट में दिया हुआ है कि कितन कितन स्थानों में यह ट्रेनिंग देने का प्रबन्ध किया गया है । माननीय मेम्बर यदि स्टेटमेंट देखेंगे तो उन्हें यह माधुम हों जायेगा ।

**Shri Frank Anthony:** Is it a fact, Sir, that because of this differential treatment during the training period, the response from teachers of the junior section has not been adequate?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** Sir, the response to the National Cadet Corps Scheme has been very encouraging indeed. As far as I know, the limiting factor is the finance, and not the lack of teachers offer themselves for training.

**Shri Frank Anthony:** May I know whether any target was set for 1952 for the number of teachers to be recruited and whether that target has been reached?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** I require notice.

**Shri Balwant Sinha Mehra:** May I know, Sir, whether this training includes naval training also and, if so, how many centres are there in the country and where are they located?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** Yes, there is provision for naval training as well as air training. There is a Naval Wing and an Air Wing in the National Cadet Corps.

**Shri Balwant Sinha Mehra:** How many centres are there?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** The question is confined to the training of teachers. The centre for naval training of the teachers and Professors is at Cochin.

**Mr. Deputy-Speaker:** I would urge hon. Members not to speak to the Minister alone; they have to speak to the whole House. Therefore they must raise their voices and must be heard. The answers must also be heard not merely by the member who puts the question but by other members of the House also.

**Shri L. N. Mishra:** Is it a fact that the Government make a specific grant for the boarding and lodging of students who attend the N.C.C. training camp centres in different States?

**Mr. Deputy-Speaker:** Hon. Members will address the Chair so that all may hear, and not address the Minister.

**Shri L. N. Mishra:** Is it a fact that specific grant was made for the lodging and boarding of these students at these centres?

**Shri Satish Chandra:** Is the hon. Member referring to teachers? The question relates to Professors and teachers and not to the N.C.C. as a whole.
