Government have seen newspaper reports that due to administrative difficulties the Portuguese authorities may postpone the introduction of this system indefinitely.

INTEGRATED PUBLICITY PROGRAMME

*1361. Shri D. C. Sharma: Shri Hem Raj:

Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

(a) the amount spent so far during the current year under the Integrated Publicity Programme of the First Five Year Plan; and

(b) whether any amcunt has been spent during this year for making documentary films on the development plans and river valley project*⁹

The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): (a) The amount spent during the current financial year upto 31st October, 1954, is Rs. 11,31,559.

(b) Yes. An amount of Rs. 4,36,627 has been spent during the current financial year upto 31st October, 1954, in making documentary films covering the entire field of Five Year Plan including development plans and river valley projects.

OVERSEAS PUBLICITY

*1362. Shri S. N. Das: Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to refer to reply given to Starred Question No. 9 asked on the 16th February, 1954 and state:

(a) whether there are any proposals for improving the arrangements for external publicity in Western and Middle East countries; (b) if so, the nature of the proposals; and

(c) the extent to which various suggestions have been implemented?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Defence (Sbrl Jawaharlai Nehru): (a) Yes.

(b) Proposals include reinforcing and re-orientating Inoian publicity set up in European and Middle East countries, with a view to increasing their efficiency.

- (c) (1) A new publicity section has been set up in our Mission in Berned
 - (2) Publicity wings in our Missions in Bonn and Beirut have been strengthened by addition of more staff.
 - (3) The publicity wing of our Mission in Baghdad, which was under a junior officer, viz. Assistant Press Attache, has been placed under a senior Press Attachc.
 - (4) It has been decided to have a regular publicity set up attached to our Consulate General in San Francisco.
