Shri Ramachandra Reddi: May I know whether this Government does not know exactly for what purpose they are exporting their commodities to other countries?

Shri Karmarkar: Not in all cases. They may be importing for making rough biscuits, for cattle feed and for something else.

EMOLUMENTS TO ECONOMISTS

*425. Shri Randaman Singh: Will the Minister of Planning be pleased to state whether any emoluments are to be paid to the Economists appointed by the Planning Commission to advise them on problems connected with the preparation of the Second Five Year Plan?

The Deputy Minister of Planning (Shri S. N. Mishra): The Members of Panel of Economists are not paid any emoluments, except the usual travelling and daily allowances for attending the meetings.

CEASE FIRE LINE

*428. Shri Chaudhri Muhammed Shaffee: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state: (a) the number of persons arrested! for violating the cease-fire line in Jammu and Kashmir State during the year 1954;

(b) the action taken against them; and

(c) the number of persons who weresent across the cease-fire line by the Indian authorities during that period?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of External Affairs (Shri Sadath Ali Khan): (a) to (c). According to information available with the Government of India, 1,205 persons were apprehended in 1954 for crossing the cease-fire line. The general, policy in such cases is to send these persons back across the cease-fire line. Exact information in regard to persons actually sent across in this manner is not available.
