(d) if so, the reactions of Government to the same?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan); (a) No, Sir.

(b) to (d). Do not arise.

GRANTS FOR ROADS

*2065. Shri Dabhi: Will the Minister of Transport be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of grant alkotted to the Bombay State for the construction of roads out of the amount set apart for the First Five Year Plan period;
- (b) how much of this amount has already been sanctioned; and
- (c) whether there are any conditions attached to the grant?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) The hon. Member is presumably referring to the ad hoc provision of Rs. 10 crores for the construction of State roads of inter-State or economic importance during the current Plan period and of a similar amount during the first two years of the Second Five Year Plan. An offer of Rs. 187:05 lakhs has been made to Bombay State out of this provision of Rs. 20 crores.

(b) Estimates aggregating to Rs. 127;88 lakhs have been sanctioned so far. Against these estimates, expenditure up to Rs. 91;71 lakhs will be met from the gant of Rs. 187;05 lakhs and the balance from State Funds.

(c) Yes.

Shri Dabhi: May I know in which area the roads have been constructed or are being constructed with the help given by the Centre?

Shri Alagesan: In the Bombay State there are fifteen schemes. They cover almost the whole area. I have the list and I can pass it on to my hon. friend.

TRAINING OF WORKERS

- *2067. Shri Ram Shankar Lal: Will the Minister of Labour be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that classes for training workers in new techniques of improved methods of productivity have been recently started at Nagpur;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to establish such other centres also in the country; and
- (c) if so, the expenditure proposed to be incurred thereon?

The Deputy Minister of Labour (Shri Abid Ali): (a) No, Sir. But one of the I.L.O. Experts has conducted at Nagpur a training course under the Scheme for Training within Industry.

- (b) Courses under the Scheme are already being conducted at Bombay and Delhi.
- (c) A sum of Rupees 46,800/- has been provided in the budget for 1955-56 for meeting expenses connected with the Scheme for Training within Industry.
