India, and the same scrutiny is applied in its case as it applied to a request from a company incorporated in India.

RURAI CREDIT SURVEY COMMITTEE

Survey which commenced about the middle of August, 1954, has, up to the end of February, 1955, been completed in 4,000 out of 4,500 about villages selected for survey. The field operations are expected to have concluded everywhere by the end of March. 1955 except in certain of Jammu and Kashmir portions where. due to inclement weather conditions, the survey has had 10 be postponed to the summer.
