provisions have been made both in the Displaced Persons (Claims) Supplementary Act 1954 and the Displaced Persons (Compensation and Rehabilitation) Act 1954. There is no legal provision, however, now for inviting fresh claims.

Sardar Hukam Singh: As these unfortunate persons suffered identically and migrated under similar circumstances, would Government consider their case also by inviting fresh claims when they are here in India since 1947?

Shri J. K. Bhonsle: Their claims cannot be examined for compensation. But it is very unfortunate that for the last seven years they should never have approached Government for examining their claims. If they do so now, we shall consider them for what are known as rehabilitation grants.

Sardar Hukam Singh: May I know whether Government would be prepared to have a fresh enactment or have an amendment made so that these unfortunate persons might also be brought within the scope of the compensation scheme.

Shri J. K. Bhonsle: That is what I have said. We will consider their case for rehabilitation grants which would be paid under the Compensation Act.

Sardar Hukum Singh: Do I understand the Minister to say that so far, for the last seven years, Government have received no representation from these unfortunate persons who have been living here and have suffered similarly?

Shri J. K. Bhonsle: Yes. I have made inquiries and I find that for the last seven years we have not received anything in the Ministry of Rehabilitation.

Sardar Hukam Singh: Have these inquiries been made from States as well where they have settled or were they limited only to the Rehabilitation Ministry in Delhi? Shri J. K. Bhonsle: They were limited to the Rehabilitation Ministry here, but all claims filed all over India for compensation have been processed here.

DOCUMENTARY FILMS

*2156. Shri Wodeyar: Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

(a) the number of do<mark>cumentary</mark> films in Kannada produced in 1954-55; and

(b) whether Government have any proposal for producing documentary films on the historical and architectural places in Karnataka?

The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): (a) Twenty.

(b) Places of historical and architectural interest in Kannada speaking areas have been covered in 8 d(cumentaries. Other such places archibelon being considered while framingthe programme for 1955-56.

Shri Wodeyar: May I know whether Government propose to film documentaries of Keladhi, Ekari and Chitraldurg in Mysore State and Kittoor in Bombay Karnatak, as historical places in Rajasthan are being filmed?

Dr. Keskar: I could not hear the first part of it.

Mr. Speaker: He refers to some places like Chitraldurg in Mysore State.

Dr. Keskar: Effort is always to get the most interesting and well known historical and architectural centres filmed, but if my hon. friend has any suggestion to make, I will be very glad to get details from him.

Shri Thimma'ah: May I know in what language the largest number of documentaries have been produced?

Dr. Keskar: *The largest number is in English, and after that will come Hindi.

•The answer was later corrected as follows vide Part II Debats dated the 19th August, 1955: The largest number is in Hindi and after that comes English". Shri Bhagwat Jha Azad: May I know what is the percentage of documentaries that are being produced in English as also those that have been produced in the regional languages? And would the hon. Minister supply us with the percentage of those who understand English?

Dr. Keskar: This was a question about Kannada documentaries. For the percentage, I will require notice.

SPINNING MILLS

*2157. Shri Ram Shankar Lal: Will the Minister of Commerce and Indutry be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of U.P. have submitted any proposal for the opening of a spinning mill for weavers on co-operative basis or otherwise; and

(b) whether any assistance in the form of a loan or grant is likely to be given for this purpose?

The Deputy Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Kanungo): (a) It is understood that the U.P. Government submitted last year some such proposal to the Handloom Board who returned it to the State Government with some suggestions. No further proposals in the light of the suggestions made have so far been received.

सरवार स्वर्ण सिंह : जी हां, अगर वे मुला-जिम हायर परचेज सिस्टम पर लेना चाहें तौ उनको इस स्कीम के मातधत अलाहदा इम-दाद दी जा सकती हैं। वह इमदाद भी स्टंट गवर्नमेंट ही द' सकती हैं। मगर थे मकानात जो म्युनिसिपल संस्थाएं बनाएंगी तो जिस वक्त वे नॉकरी छोइंगे उनको खाली करने पइंगे क्योंकि उनकी जगह नए मुलाजिम उन मकानों को आक_पाई करंगे।

डा० सत्ववादी: इस काम के लिए क्या म्युनि-सिपल बाडीज के मुलाजिमों की कोआपरीटव हाउसिंग सौसाइटीब को कोई मदद दी गई हैं या नहीं?

मरदार स्वर्णसिंहः वह भी इस जनरल स्कीम के मातहत फायदा उठा सकते हैं।
