UPPER CLASS BOGIES

*899. **Pandit M. B. Bhargava:** Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Upper Class Bogies which used to be attached to 201 UP/202 DN. Ex-Ajmer to Delhi and vice versa have been discontinued thus causing inconvenience to Upper Class passengers;

(b) if so, since when and the reason therefor; and

(c) whether Government would re-introduce the same?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Shah Nawaz Khan): (a) and (b). Due to lack of sufficient traffic justification the second class coach, which was running between Delhi and Ajmer, was replaced by a third class coach from 10-9-54.

(c) From 1-3-55, the second class coach has been re-introduced to run between Delhi and Ajmer by Nos. 201/202 Delhi Mail trains.
