The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): (a) and (b). On the basis of a subsidy of 50 per cent. arrangements for supplying about 2,000 sets by March, 1955 have been made. The payment of a subsidy of Rs. 1,50,000 in respect of 1,000 sets has so far been approved.

## FLOOD CONTROL IN TRIPURA

\*1050. Shri Biren Dutt: Will the Minister of Irrigation and Power be pleased to refer to the reply given to starred question No. 30 on the 23rd August, 1954 and state the nature of the schemes formulated for controlling floods in Tripura?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): The schemes formulated for controlling floods in Tripura States are as follows:—

- Raising and strengthening the embankments;
- (2) Providing spurs, Double Groynes and Brush Wood pitching for erosion control;
- (3) Providing sluice gates for-
  - (i) preventing high flood water of the rivers entering beels.
  - (ii) draining water in beels into the river where river water is low.

## INDIAN EXPLOSIVES LIMITED

\*1064. Shri K. C. Sodhia: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state by what time the Indian Explosives, Limited is likely to go into production?

The Deputy Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Kanungo): It is expected that the factory might begin trial production in about three years' time.
