- *1077. Shri T. B. Vittal Rao: Will the Minister of Works, Housing and Supply be pleased to state:
- (a) the total amount of subsidy paid to the Hyderabad Government for the construction of houses for Industrial Workers under the Subsidised Industrial Housing Scheme during the period from the 1st April, 1952 to the 31st December, 1954; and
- (b) the number of tenements actually constructed in that State during the above period and the number still under construction?

The Minister of Works. Housing and Supply (Sardar Swaran Singh): (a) Rs. 4.06 lakhs.

(b) On 31-12-54, the construction of 2,399 tenements had been completed and 1,136 were under construction.

SYNTHETIC MICA

- (a) whether Government have taken any steps to ascertain the authenticity of the reports about the preparation of synthetic mica somewhere in U.S.A.; and
- (b) whether Government have ascertained how far scrap mica exported from India is used or is likely to be used in the manufacture of synthetic mica?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri Karmarkar): (a) Yes, Sir. Government understand that there has been some production of synthetic mica in the U.S.A.

(b) The extent to which scrap-mica exported from India is used or is likely to be used in the manufacture of synthetic mica is not yet known.
