Shri Alagesan: I think there is a certain amount of confusion. It is not the Government that is standing in the way at all. These Conference are voluntary associations of shipping lines engaged in this trade. They submit voluntarily to certain rules and regulations. We are keeping in close touch with the shipping companies. It may be that if the Government takes some hasty steps, we may be embarrassing our shipping interests. We are keeping these in mind and we try to help them as far as possible.

Shri Alagesan: (a) 250.

(b) Twenty Locomotives per month, approximately.

श्री नवल प्रभाकर : क्या मैं जान सकता हूँ कि सन् १९५२ में कितने इंजन मरम्मत के लिए आये और १९५२ के असें में कितने इंजन तैयार करके भेजे गये ?

Shri Alagesan: I have got figures for 1954. Two hundred and fifty

metre gauge engines were received in the workshop: periodical overhauling 113, intermediate overhauling 84 and special 53.

श्री नवल प्रभाकर : क्या मैं जान सकता हूँ कि इस मीटर गेज के ऊपर नये इंजनों का निर्माण करने का विचार अजमेर में है ?

Shri Alagesan: We are having metre gauge engines manufactured in TELCO.

Shri Ajit Singh: May I know whether private locomotives are also taken for repairs and if so, what are the prescribed rules?

Shri Alagesan: I have no idea. The hon. Member may put a separate question. I shall find out.

Shri T. B. Vittal Rao: May I know whether the Committee appointed to assess the utilisation of the various workshops in India has submitted its report?

Shri Alagesan: Not yet.
