**The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. P. Jain):** (a) Yes.

(b) The agricultural literature is mainly printed in English and Hindi. Some posters have, however, been produced in regional languages such as Bengali, Gujerati, Gurmukhi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Tamil, Telugu and Urdu.

(c) The agricultural research literature is distributed through the Directors of Agriculture, Directors of Information and Publicity, Co-operative Societies, Colleges, Public Libraries, Agricultural Institutions in the States and Trade Organisations and Associations. The Literature is also supplied to the officers-in-charge of Community Projects, Extension and Development Blocks, Village Panchayats and the Village-Level workers; through these channels it reaches the cultivators and the masses. In certain cases individual agents are also employed on commission basis to stock and sell the literature wherever required. The Manager of Publications, Government of India, keeps a ready stock of such literature for sale. It is also distributed at *Melas*, exhibitions and cattle shows.

(d) The information is being collected. It will be placed on the Table of the Sabha when received.
