Honnemaradu Project

*629. Shri N. Rachish: Shri Wodeyar:

- (b) the probable capacity of the Pro ject; and
- (c) whether Government have decided to include it in the Second Five Year Plan?

Trade with Afghauistan

*634. Shri M. Islamuddin: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the trade with Afghanistan, is interfered with due to blockade of the normal trade routes through Pakistan; and
- (b) if so, the steps Government propose to take in the matter?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri Karmarkar): (a) Yes, Sir. It has been represented by the trade that considerable quantities of merchandise belonging to Indians destined for Afghanistan are held up in Pakistan.

(b) The matter has been taken up with the Government of Pakistan.

Import Policy

*638. Th. Jugal Kishore Sinha: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state the effect on Small Scale Industries as a result of liberalising the policy of import for the Second half of this year ?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri Karmarkar): Small Scale Industries have not been adversely affected by the changes made in the import policy for the second half of 1955. The policy has been libera-lised mainly in the case of items needed for industry or for meeting increases in demand which have not been matched by corresponding increases in domestic production. The interests of small scale industries as well as large and medium industries were prominently kept in view while enhancing quotas for various items.
