Shri S. N. Mishra: The number of trainees in each vocation would come up to about 20; and there are 20 vocations in which the boys are to be trained. So, the total number would come to 160, but at the present moment, 40 are being trained.

So far as the question of boys being taken from outside is concerned, I think there does not seem to be any embargo on that.

Shri S. C. Samanta: May I know whether Government have any proposal to provide those trainees who will have training there with any vocational assistance within the community project area after the completion of their course?

Shri S. N. Mishra: That does not seem to be the purpose behind such training.

Textile Enquiry Committee

- *22. Shri Gadilingana Gowd: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 2372 on the 19th April, 1955 and state:
- (a) whether Government have since taken any decision on the Report of the Textile Enquiry Committee; and
- (b) if so, which of their recommendations have been accepted?

The Deputy Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Kanungo): (a) and (b). Government have not yet taken any decisions on this report.

Shri Gadilingana Gowd: How long will it take for Government to come to a decision in the matter?

Shri Kanungo: As soon as possible.

Shri Nanadas: May I know what are the reasons for not taking a decision in this matter?

Shri Kanungo: There are no particular reasons. One reason was that the Report was not available in print in full.

Shri B. S. Murthy: What are the recommendations made by the Committee?

Mr. Speaker: Order, order. The recommendations are being considered.

Shri Kanungo: Copies of the Report are available in the Library.

Shri T. S. A. Chettiar: May I know whether the recent statement of the hon. Minister of Commerce and Industry that he is a complete convert to the philosophy of the handloom will have any influence in coming to a decision over this Report?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): The hon. Member is at liberty to judge for himself.

Jute Bags

*25. Pandit D. N. Tiwary: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state whether there hav been any negotiations with Turkey for the supply of jute bags?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri' Karmarkar): No., Sir.

Pandit D. N. Tiwary: May I know whether sometime past licences for the import of Indian jute goods were cancelled by the Turkish Government because of acute shortage of foreign exchange?

Shri Karmarkar: So far as jute goods are concerned, I find that during 1955 about 2,700 tons have been passed for shipment.

Pandit B. N. Tiwary: May I know whether India has become self-sufficient in jute goods? If not, for what reasons are jute goods being exported?

Shri Karmarkar: We have a surplus of jute goods, as my hon. friend ought to know.

Shri L. N. Mishra: May I know whether Government are aware of the fact that some European traders in jute have joined together to fight with the Indian jute exports? If so, what steps are Government going to take to face that?

Shri Karmarker: I am aware of all the aspects relating to Turkey. Is the hon. Member speaking with reference to Turkey?

Low-income Group Housing Scheme

*27. Chaudhri Muhammed Shaffee: Will the Minister of Works, Housing and Supply be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 1647 on the 29th March, 1955 and state the total loan sanctioned and the payments made so far to the Jammu and Kashmir State Government under the Low-income Group Housing Scheme?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri-Karmarker): The total loan allocation made so far to the Jammu and Kachmir Government under the Scheme is Rs. 35 Lakhs. The State Government have not yet asked for any payment against this allocation.

Shri B. Ni Mishrar May I know which are the States where this scheme is in operation and how much the Government have given till now to each of those States?

Shri Karmerkar: It is a long list of 24 States. If you permit me, I shall read it.

Mr. Spenker: It takes a long time. He may place it on the Table of the House.

Shri Sadath Ali Khan: Various aspects before opening a Mission in a foreign country are considered, such as trade, cultural relations and diplomatic relations. Everything is taken into consideration.
