HEAVY WATER PLANT

*1054. { Shri M. S. Gurupadaswamy: Dr. Ram Subhag Singh :

Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state :

(b) whether Government have collected any material on the working and the processes of making heavy water in other countries; and

Our Deputy High Commissioner in Lahore recently received a voluntary gift of cloth worth Rs. 1,000 from the Calcutta Marwari Relief Society, for distribution as relief among the non-Muslim inmates of the D.A.V. College Camp at Lahore, who have for some time been awaiting evacuation to India. The distribution was made by the Deputy High Commissioner's wife in the presence of a representative of the Society.
