## The Minister in the Ministry Communications (Shri Raj Bahadur): (a) 18.

- (b) Total number of circuits leased out to Press and News agencies upto date is 111.
- (c) It is not possible to give the cost of erection of the circuits. Generally the Government do not erect circuits for the parties. The Department only supply them spare channels, which are already built up. The demands from Government offices as well as from the Public are, however, kept in view in laying out new Voice Frequency Telegraphs systems. New construction is only taken up when absolutely essential or when only portion of the line has to be erected.
