

Shri Kanungo : Some of the Branches have started functioning. Usually, a Branch Institute consists of an Assistant Director and a few technical officers and field officers.

Shri S. V. Ramaswamy : What is the basis on which these Branch Institutes are located? Is it because in those places there are small-scale industries or is it on any other basis?

Shri Kanungo : It is generally on the basis of where access by small industrial units to the Institute would be easier.

Shri B. S. Murthy : May I know whether it has been brought to the notice of the Ministry that the area allotted to each of these Institutes is rather large and, therefore, effective guidance could not be given; and, if so, what arrangements are being made in this respect?

Shri Kanungo : I am afraid there is a little confusion. The main Institutes have large areas and that is why Branch Institutes are being organised and we expect that each State will have one Branch Institute.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES IN ORISSA

*1758. **Shri Sanganna :** Will the Minister of Planning be pleased to state :

(a) whether any schemes of economic development outside the First Five-Year Plan have been launched in the State of Orissa by the Government of India ;

(b) if so, what are they; and

(c) whether the State Government have been asked to contribute anything towards it?

The Deputy Minister of Planning (Shri S. N. Mishra) : (a) to (c). The hon. Member presumably wants to have information about the Centrally sponsored schemes executed in Orissa. A statement is laid on the Table of the House indicating these schemes

and the contribution made by the Government of Orissa during the First Five Year Plan. [See Appendix X, annexure No. 28]. I should, however, point out that though the schemes are not included in the State Plan as such, they form part of the National Plan.

Shri Sanganna : May I know whether the amounts shown in the statement are inclusive of the amounts allotted to the Government of Orissa during the first Five Year Plan?

Shri S. N. Mishra : Yes, Sir. All the amount that was given to the Government of Orissa for the implementation of the schemes under Plan is included.

Shri Sanganna : May I know whether all the schemes shown in the statement have been completed during the First Five Year Plan period and if not, which of the schemes have been carried over to the Second Five Year Plan.

Shri S. N. Mishra : For that, I would require separate notice.

Shri Sanganna : May I know the reasons why these schemes have not been included in the First Five Year Plan and whether they are not also included in the Second Five Year Plan as a carry over of the schemes which were incomplete during the First Five Year Plan?

Shri S. N. Mishra : I have already submitted that they are part of the national Plan.

सीमा घटनायें (पश्चिमी पाकिस्तान)

*१७५६. **श्री रघुनाथ सिंह :** क्या प्रधान मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि कराची में सीटो-सम्मेलन होने के बाद पाकिस्तानियों ने कितनी बार पश्चिमी पाकिस्तान की ओर से भारतीय सीमाओं का उल्लंघन किया और उन पर आक्रमण किया है ?

बैदेशिक-कार्य मंत्री के सभासचिव (श्री सादत अली खां) : छ: बार ।

श्री रघुनाथ सिंह : इसमें कितने ग्रादमी घायल हुए और कितने ग्रादमियों की हत्या हुई ?

श्री सावत अली खां : १७ और १६ मार्च को फीरोजपुर जिले में, फीरोजपुर हडवर्क्स के पास जो हादसा हुआ, उसमें हमारी सेना के चार ग्रादमी मारे गये और २१ ग्रादमी जख्मी हुए ।

Shri D. C. Sharma : May I know how many times the air space has been violated during the very same period?

Shri Sadath Ali Khan : I am talking about the earth and not about air.

Shri D. C. Sharma : May I know what action Government has taken to prevent the recurrence of these border incidents?

The Deputy Minister of External Affairs (Shri Anil K. Chanda) : This is a matter which has been referred to many times on the floor of this House. And, the Prime Minister, only a few days ago said that it is impossible to completely prevent a recurrence of incidents of this nature, considering the long border line involved. But, every possible effort is taken to prevent such incidents.

श्री एम० एल० द्विवेदी : मैं यह जानना चाहता हूँ कि क्या पाकिस्तान और हिन्दुस्तान के बीच में बाउंडरी (सीमा) को सेंटिल (तय) करने के लिये, जिससे कि ऐसे हमले न हो सकें, कोई कमीशन बैठा है, और क्या पाकिस्तान और हिन्दुस्तान ने मिलकर कोई काम किया है, यदि हां तो इसमें अब तक क्या तरक्की हुई है?

Shri Anil K. Chanda : The two Directors-General of Survey have met recently and they are having details worked out.

Shri M. L. Dwivedi : How much of the plan has been worked out.

Shrimati Khongmen : Are Government aware of similar violent attacks made by the Pakistanis on the eastern frontier; and if so, what is the number of such occasions?

Mr. Speaker : This question refers to West Pakistan.

Sardar Iqbal Singh : In view of the fact that according to the Pant-Mirza agreement some arms have been taken away from civilian population living in those areas, will Government consider the restoration of these arms?

Shri Sadath Ali Khan : I have no information that any arms have been taken away from civilian population.

Sardar Iqbal Singh : Will the hon. Parliamentary Secretary make enquiries and lay a statement on the Table of the House?

Shri Sadath Ali Khan : I shall make enquiries.

AGREEMENT WITH U. S. S. R.

***1760. Dr. Ram Subhag Singh :** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state the estimated value of the cottage industries products which the Soviet Union will buy under the recent trade agreement between India and U.S.S.R.

The Minister of Commerce (Shri Karmarkar) : Presumably the hon. Member is referring to the joint Indo-Soviet Communique issued on December, 1955, which states, amongst other things that the U.S.S.R. would increase substantially her purchases from India. The Communique does not specify the commodities which the U.S.S.R. will buy from India or their quantity or value. We, however,
