is being provided with roof and the rest has no roof with the result that passengers are exposed to sun and rain?

Oral Answers

Shri Alagesan: The entire length of the platform is always not covered by roof. It is only a portion that is so covered. I do not know the length which is being covered and the length left uncovered.

Shri Ramachandra Reddi: When is the work likely to be recommenced?

Shri Alagesan: It is already proceeding.

Bongaigaon Workshop

*641. Shri Debendra Nath Sarma: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to enlarge the workshop at Bongaigaon in the N. E. Rly. for repairing and complete overhauling of coaches and wagons; and
- (b) if so, from when the work will be started?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Shahnawas Khan): (a) and (b) The matter is under consideration of the Railway Board.

Shri Debendra Nath Sarma: How long will it take to finalise the matter?

Shri Shahnawaz Khan : As soon as the Railway Board has considered it.

Aerodrome at Udaipur

*642. Shri Balwant Sinha Mehta: Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- the construction (a) whether Aerodrome at Udaipur has been completed:
- (b) if so, to what important places it will be linked with in the country; and
 - (c) when the service will be operated?

The Minister of Natural Resources (Shri K. D. Malaviya): (a) No, Sir. The work is expected to be completed by the end of 1956.

(b) and (c) The question of starting a scheduled or feeder service through Udaipu and connecting it with other places in the country will be examined after the aeredrome has been constructed.

Shri Balwant Sinha Mehta: May I know the total estimated cost, and how much has been spent so far?

Shri K. D. Malaviya: The latest revised estimate of the CPWD is Rs. 8.75 lakhs, exclusive of departmental charges which will work out to abo ut Rs. 70,000. The progress so far made is:

Runway: Soling and metalling complete.

Strips: Filling in progress, 90 per cent, work completed.

Domestic Accommodation: Complete except electric supply.

Terminal Building: Work in progress. Fencing: Complete.

Air Service between Ratnagiri and Konkan Coast

Shri Kajrolkar: Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Indian Airlines Corporation have worked out a programme to start an air service to Ratnagiri on the Konkan coast;
- (b) if so, whether the construction of an aerodrome at Ratnagiri has been undertaken;
- (c) if not, when the construction work will commence; and
- (d) when the air service to Ratnagiri is expected to commence?

The Minister of Natural Resources (Shri K. D. Malaviya): (a) to (d). It has been decided to construct an aerodrome at Ratnagiri during the Second Five Year Plan. The construction work is expected to be started during 1957-58. The question of operating an air service to Ratnagiri can arise only after the aerodrome at Ratnagiri has been completed.
