Shri A. P. Jain: The export policy is decided twice in a year, in the beginning of the year and in the middle of the year. The export policy with regard to these commodities was decided in the middle of 1955, and permission was given. As soon as it was found that the prices were going up, turther exports were prohibited, and only those persons who had entered into firm contracts for the export, before the prohibition, were allowed to fulfil those contracts after the prohibition had come in.
