Class II Gazeted Officers

*527. Shri Khardekar: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) the lowest scale of salary for Class II Gazetted Officers in any department of the Government of India as recommended by the Pay Commission and as accepted by Government; and
- (b) the date from which this has been given effect to?

The Minister of Revenue and Civil Expenditure (Shri M. C. Shah): (a) The Central Pay Commission recommended that a scale of Rs. 275-25-500—EB—30-650-EB-30-800 would generally be an appropriate scale for Class II posts in the Central Services but observed that it was not necessary to go upto the maximum of Rs. 800 for all officers in Class II. Government acc epted this recommendation.

Information about the lowest scale of pay for Class II Gazetted Officers in particular Departments of the Government of India would, in some cases, necessitate a reference to Ministries concerned and this will take time. However, some of the lower Class II scales prescribed for certian posts are given below.

Rs. 275-25-500

Rs. 350-25-500

Rs. 325-25-500-EB-30-590

Rs. 400-25-450

There are certain posts which have been classified as Class II and Gazetted for special reasons but they carry lower scales of pay than the general pattern.
