## Pakistan Nationals in India

${ }^{*}$ 31. Shri Krishnacharya Joshi: Will the Minister of Home Aftairs be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 185 on the 21st November, 1956 and state:
(a) whether the movements of visitors from Pakistan are effectively controlled in the interest of security of India:
(b) the total number of Pakistanis who overstayed during 1956; and
(c) the action taken against them?

The Minister in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar): (a) to (c). Legislation has recently been undertaken to exercise effective control over the movements of Pakistani nationals where it is necessary in the interest of security of the country to take action against those who have overstayed the period of authorised residence. Information as to the exact number of persons falling in the latter category will be known only after the new law has been in force for some time.

Shri Krishnacharya Joshi: May I know how many unauthorised Pakistanis have come to India, and how many have come with visas?
