- (d) Developmental activities proposed to be taken up with the World Bank

aid include improving the capability of State Governments to analyse development constraints and establish priorities; develop Institutions for rendering costeffective service to farmers; support priority investment Programmes in agricultural and rural development identified in the State agricultural perspective plan; to accelerate the growth of agriculture through improved technical, financial and economic use of resources: and enhance sustainability of the productive resource base.
