## **Spurious Products**

\*350. SHRI V. SREENIVASA PRASAD: SHRI TARA SINGH:

Will the Minister of CIVIL SUPPLIES, CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state;

- (a) whether there is a persistant demand to make the manufacture of spurious and counterfeit products cognizable offence with severe punishment;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto:
- (c) whether the Government have any proposal to bring suitable changes in the laws to check manufacture of such consumer items; and
  - (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL SUPPLIES, CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI A. K. ANTONY) (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d) The subject matter of spurious and counterfeit products falls within the purview of a number of enactments like the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, the Trade and Merchandise Marks Act, 1958, etc. These legislations are administered by a number of Ministries such as the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the Ministry of Industry, etc.

The Ministry of Industry has introduced the Trade and Merchandise Marks (Amendment) Bill. 1993 in the Lok Sabha on 19.4.1993 which provides for enhancing the penalties for applying false trade marks, false trade description, etc.

(c) The seeds of improved varieties re made available to the farmers by the seeds multiplication Agencies like State Seed Corporations and National Seeds Corporation etc. at reasonable rates.
