- (d) the stage at which the matter stands at present?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (CAPT. SATISH KUMAR SHARMA): (a) yes, Sir.

- (c) the quantity of oil extracted from these basins ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (CAPT. SATISH KUMAR SHARMA)(a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Of the seven wells tested/under testing in KG and Cauvery basins during January 1994, 4 wells proved to be hydrocarbon bearing and 3 proved dry. In addition, 18 wells inculding one development well were under drilling as on 13.1.1994.
- (c) details of basin-wise crude oil prodution including condensate from Southern region of ONGC since inception (till March, 1994) is as follows:-
