Malaria Vaccine

408. SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) whether a vaccine has been developed to combat Malaria ;

(b) if so, the details thereof ;

(c) whether this vaccine is approved by WHO after sufficient trials;

(d) if so, the details thereof ; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A. R. ANTULAY): (a) and (b). A Malaria Vaccine was developed in Colombia but has not been found to be effective in immunising human being against Malaria ; initial trials had however shown encouraging results.

(c) to (e). As reported WHO has not approved any Malaria vaccine including the one developed in Colombia.

Supply of Spare Parts

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT) AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUM): (a) to (d) Government of India have signed a number of Memoranda of Understanding/Protocols with Russia which includes one for guaranteed supply of Defence equipment related items/spare parts, product support and comprehensive services needed for maintenance/repairs overhaul and modernisation. Following the break up of the erstwhile USSR, Government have also been pursuing a policy of establishing contacts with Russia as well as each of the successor States of the former USSR for promotion of Defence Cooperation.

Simultaneously, Government are also pursuing measures to sustain defence imports from other sources and to strengthen indigenous production facilities to ensure that the defence requirements of the country are fully met with the objective of self reliance in production of defence spares.

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A. R. ANTULAY) : (a) and (b). An ODA assisted health and family welfare project is being implemented in 5 districts of Orissa namely ; Keonjhar, Sambalpur, Mayurbhanj, Dhenkanal and Sundergarh.

(c) and (d). Under the project, so far 406 Sub Centres, 88 Lady Health Visitor Quarters, 10 Ten-bedded ward with Operational Theater at Community Health Centre / Sub-Divisional Hospitals, 135 staff quarters at PHC, 108 staff quarters at SDHs and 82 staff quarters at CHCs have been constructed. Furniture and equipments have also been supplied to all the Sub Centres / PHCs / SDHs / CHCs. etc. Till now, 23041 medical and para-medical functionaries have been trained under the project.

The total sanctioned cost of the project is Rs. 65.66 crores and the grant-in-aid released so far to the State is Rs. 59.09 crores upto Septmeber, 1995.

Sainik Vidyalayas
