- (b) Scheduled Castes 9; Scheduled Tribes None.
- (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) Scheduled Caste 149; Scheduled Tribe 8.
- (e) The requisite provision to provide reservation for SC/ST exists in the Delhi Higher Judicial Service Rules, 1970. Rule 22 thereof provides that the reservation of posts for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes shall be in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. As regards provision of reservation for OBC candidates in the Higher Judicial Service; Central Government has already taken up the matter with Government of NCT of Delhi/Delhi High Court for making suitable amendment in Delhi Higher Judicial Service Rules, 1970.

## Foreign Assessment for Health Projects

595. SHRI D. VENKATESWARA RAO : SHRI BOLLA BULLI RAMAIAH :

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether he discussed a proposal with a delegation of Edward Dunlop Hospitals (India) Ltd. to set up 56 State-of-the-Health Medical Care Centres accross the country during 1995-96;
- (b) if so, whether he met the delegation alongwith members of consortium from Canada, Australia and UK;
- (c) the places where these projects are likely to be set up; and
- (d) to what extent people of the area are likely to be benefitted?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A.R. ANTULAY): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir.

- (c) It is in an explaratory stage. The project aims at establishing a chain of hospitals, Polyclinics and diagnostic centres to be established at Delhi, Bombay and surrounding areas in the initial phase.
- (d) There would be increased availability of specialised hospital and diagnostic facilities within the country after the project materialises.

## War Widows

- (a) the number of War Widows assisted by the Zilla Sainik Board, Gopeshwar, Chamoli (UP) so far;

- (c) whether it is a fact that the ZSB Gopeshwar has failed to reach the goal;
- (d) if so, the reason therefor and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
  - (e) the efforts being made to reach the goal?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE-RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT) AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) to (e). The Zila Sainik Boards (ZSB) function under the administrative control of their respective State Governments. The Government of Uttar Pradesh have informed that the ZSB Gopeshwar in Chamoli have assisted 34 War Widows during the last three years and have spent an amount of Rs. 6.8 lakhs. Each of these 34 War Widows has been granted a housing grant of Rs. 5,000 and cash award of Rs. 15,000. Case-wise and location-wise information is not available.

The information regarding goals and targets which might have been fixed by the State Government for ZSB Gopeshwar is not available.
