THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI RAGHUVANSH PRASAD SINGH): (a) No. Sir.

- (b) Only small proportion of the cooperative dairies in the country are running on losses.
- (c) and (d). The Andhra Pradesh Dairy Development Cooperative Federation is incurring losses. The main reasons for the losses are carry over of losses incurred by the State Dairy Corporation from which units were transferred to the cooperative federation, inadequate margin of sale prices over procurement prices and excessive staff costs.
- (e) The Government of India has formulated a scheme for rehabilitation of dairy cooperatives.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MOHD. MAQBOOL DAR): (a) and (b). Eight persons have been arrested by the Delhi Police in this connection. These are (i) Farookh Ahmed Khan. (ii) Smt. Farida @ Behnji. (iii) Mirza Iftiqar Hussain @ Saba. (iv) Mohd. Naushad. (v) Mohd. Ali Bhatt @ Killey. (vi) Mirza Nissar Hussain. (vii) Latif Ahmed Waza and (viii) Sayed Maqbool Shah.

- (c) The interrogation of the arrested persons reveals that the man behind the sinister plan to cause bomb blasts in various town in the country is based in Pakistan. He was provided RDX for explosions by Pak ISI.
- (d) and (e). The Government of Pakistan is aware of the views of the Government of India regarding Pakistan's continued involvement in terrorist activities. The Government of India has on several occasions urged Pakistan to stop forthwith its support to terroristactivities. Pakistan has denied the allegation of its involvement in the Lajpat Nagar Bomb blast case.
