Deep Sea Exploration

704. SHRI B.L. SHANKAR: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the attention of the Government has been drawn to news-item captioned "ONGC plans to undertake deep sea exploration" appearing in the "Times of India" dated July 4, 1997.
 - (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) the places where he deep sea exploration is proposed to be done during 1997-98, State-wise;
- (d) the estimated production of petroleum products as a result thereof during 1997-98 and the remaining period of Ninth Five Year Plan; and
 - (e) the estimated cost of exploration per barrel?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. ONGC has prioritised three deep water locations for drilling in 1997-98, one each in the Kerala-Konkan, Krishna-Godavari and Cauvery basin.

- (d) The production of crude oil from deep sea locations will depend on the results of exploration activities planned during 1997-98.
- (e) It is not feasible to estimate the cost of exploration per barrel at this juncture.
