It is proposed to develop 70 growth centres in the first phase out of which locations of 61 growth centres have been identified and an-A list of growth centres nounced. announced so far is given in the attached statement. Each growth centre would be developed at a cost of approximately Rs. 25-30 crores. sum of Rs. 50 crores has been cluded in the Statement of Budget Estimates for 1991-92 for this scheme
