- (a) the quantity of edible oil imported during 1990-91 and the actual value of import; and
- (b) the quantity of oilseed supplied by the National Seeds Corporation during 1990-91 to each State against the actual demand?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICUL-TURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) The quantity of edible oil imported during the Oil Year 1990-91 (from November 1990 upto July 1991) is 89,941 MT and the value of imports is Rs. 62.25 crores.

(b) The National Seeds Corporation has supplied 25,553 quintals of oilseeds in different States during 1990-91 against the actual demand of 22.355 quintals of seeds. Details are given in the attached Statement.
