The central team which came to take stock of the situation went to the districts like Nanded and Nagpur. But they did not visit my Lok Sabha constituency and undertook a survey to evaluate the losses.

Hence, I request the central government to send their team to undertake a survey to assess the damage caused to the crops due to heavy rains in my Dharashiv District too and also provide substantial help to the needy and distressed farmers.
