Title: Regarding Opening up of Kendriya Vidyalaya schools in each district of Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, and Wanaparthy.

SHRI RAMULU POTHUGANTI (NAGARKURNOOL): Thank you, hon. Chairperson, Sir. My Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency in Telangana State is one of the very backward regions in the country. The newly created districts namely Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, and Wanaparthy fall under my Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency. The literacy rate in this place is very low. In this context, I am constrained to bring to the kind notice of the hon. Minister of Education that not even a single Kendriya Vidyalaya school is established here till now.

As a result of the same, students of this region are forced to study in private schools which are very expensive for their poor parents as most of them are farmers, workers, and labourers in this region. Opening up of Kendriya Vidyalaya schools in each district of Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, and Wanaparthy is the need of the hour.

Through you, I would, therefore, earnestly request the hon. Minister of Education that Kendriya Vidyalayas in Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, and Wanaparthy districts -- which are newly created districts in my Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency -- may kindly be sanctioned in the interests of students at large.
