**(a) whether the Ministry organised special campaign 2.0 for cleanliness from 02 October to 31 October 2022 and if so, the details and purpose thereof;**

**(a) & (b) Ministry of Civil Aviation participated in the Special Campaign 2.0 for disposal of pending matters and Swachhata from 02nd-31st October, 2022 with the objective of institutionalising Swachhata and reducing pendency in Government offices. Apart from the Ministry, all Attached Offices, including field offices, Autonomous Bodies and PSUs participated in the campaign.**

**The cleanliness campaign was conducted at 134 locations across the country. During the campaign, a total of 43224 physical files were reviewed, out of which 32919 physical files were weeded out, 42,786**

**square feet of space freed and revenue of Rs. 2,65,91,760/- generated from scrap disposal. Additionally, 582 Public Grievances and 145 Public Grievance Appeals were also disposed during the campaign.**

**(c) New Terminal Buildings are under construction at Kanpur, Jammu, Gwalior, Jabalpur and Rewa airports. Flights to Kanpur, Jammu, Gwalior and Jabalpur are already operational from existing terminals and flights from Rewa and other New Terminal Buildings can start once the said terminals are operationalised.**
